## Mode d'emploi

Maximum quantity recommended in % of the total weight of the mixing :

Pigment black	2%
Pigment white	2%
Pigment yellow	1%
Pigment red	1%

- Acrystal pigments must be mixed into the Acrystal liquid, before incorporation of the powder.
- Different colours can be mixed together.
